



Job Description for Part Time Adult Facilitator

Engage Thru Tech is seeking an adult (at least 18 years old) to assist and lead workshops and camps with youth and older children involving video production, animation, and computer activities. The ability to lead discussions reflecting on these activities, and to facilitate participant collaboration, teamwork, and social empathy, is a must. Females are preferred, as frequently these workshops involve leading groups of Girl Scouts in discussing sensitive topics unique to girls.

This part time position will involve 15-25 hours per week during the school year, and then as much as 40 hours per week over the course of the five weeks that we hold camps each summer. Hourly wage is dependent upon experience. Work hours are scheduled when students are not in school; during the school calendar year, shifts will be during evenings and weekends. During the summer months, shifts will be daytime, weekday hours. This position might be ideal for a person who is an adult student, herself.

Basic computer skills (such as navigating a computer, copying and saving files, connecting to the internet, etc) is a must. Experience with some form of non-linear video editing software is highly desirable (we will teach what you don't know). The applicant must have experience and the ability to lead groups of children and youth, including participants with a variety of backgrounds and needs.
